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- 4. **Practical Relevance:** The emphasis on professional practice ensures that students gain hands-on experience, enhancing their employability and industry readiness.
- 5. **Clear Feasibility Assessment:** The research effectively argues that the project is viable, considering both technical knowledge and transversal skill development.

Areas for Improvement

- 1. **Methodological Clarity:** The study would benefit from a more detailed explanation of the methodology used to analyze curricular convergence and select the five programs.
- 2. **Implementation Challenges:** While the feasibility of the project is discussed, potential logistical, financial, and operational challenges should be further explored.
- 3. **Stakeholder Involvement:** The perspectives of faculty members, students, and industry professionals could be incorporated to strengthen the argument for the Restaurant-School.
- 4. **Assessment Metrics:** Including specific evaluation criteria for measuring the success of the initiative would provide a clearer roadmap for implementation.
- 5. **Comparative Analysis:** A discussion on similar models implemented in other universities could provide additional insights and validation for the proposed project.

Conclusion Overall, the study presents a compelling case for the establishment of a multidisciplinary Restaurant-School at UNRC. The research effectively highlights the benefits of integrating students from different educational modalities, fostering active learning and professional development. Addressing the identified areas for improvement would further strengthen the study's impact and practical applicability.
