Reviewer's Comment for Publication.

The paper presents a rare case of duodenal trichobezoar, a location not commonly documented. Highlights the psychological aspects (trichotillomania and trichophagia) linked to trichobezoar formation. It is a unique and well-documented case report with clear clinical relevance. Needs minor language refinements, expanded discussion, and more statistical context.

Reviewer's Comment / Report

Strengths of the Paper:

1. Novelty and Clinical Significance: The paper presents a rare case of duodenal trichobezoar, a location not commonly documented. Highlights the psychological aspects (trichotillomania and trichophagia) linked to trichobezoar formation.

2. Well-Structured Case Report: Provides clear chronological details from patient history to diagnosis, treatment, and follow-up. Includes clinical findings, imaging results, and surgical procedures, making it informative for clinicians.

3. **Diagnostic and Treatment Insights**: Discusses CT imaging as a key diagnostic tool, reinforcing its utility in trichobezoar cases. Explains the challenges of endoscopic extraction and the necessity for surgical intervention. Emphasizes postoperative psychiatric care, underlining a multidisciplinary treatment approach.

4. Use of Figures & Literature Support: Includes CT scan images, endoscopic findings, and surgical extraction photos, aiding visualization. References relevant literature on bezoars, supporting the discussion with prior studies.

Areas for Improvement:

1. Language and Readability Issues: Some grammatical errors and awkward phrasing reduce clarity. Example: "We present an original case of a trichobezoar located exclusively in the duodenum, a presentation that, to the best of our knowledge, has not been previously described."

Suggestion: Rewriting for conciseness, e.g., "*This is the first documented case of an isolated duodenal trichobezoar, to our knowledge.*"

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2. **Discussion Could Be Expanded**: The etiology and pathophysiology of trichobezoars could be elaborated. Comparison with other case studies would strengthen the argument that this case is unique. **Suggestion:** A brief table summarizing previously reported cases could improve the discussion.

3. Lack of Statistical or Epidemiological Data: The paper mentions incidence rates but lacks detailed statistics or comparative analysis.

Suggestion: Including a literature review summary on the prevalence of trichobezoars in different locations would enhance context.

4. **More Focus on Alternative Treatments**: The discussion briefly mentions chemical dissolution (e.g., Coca-Cola® therapy) but does not explore its effectiveness in detail.

Suggestion: A short section on pros and cons of non-surgical treatments would be useful.
