Strengths of the Article

✓ Relevant and Timely Topic

- The study of globalization's impact on Indian society is highly relevant, especially in the context of rapid urbanization, cultural shifts, and economic liberalization.
- The paper touches on important themes like family structure changes, gender roles, economic inequalities, and identity conflicts.

✓ Well-Structured Discussion

- The paper follows a logical sequence, covering definitions, theoretical perspectives, and real-life implications of globalization.
- Key sections, such as political, technological, and cultural dimensions, provide a multi-faceted approach.

✓ Use of Scholarly Sources

- The author references Amartya Sen, as well as other studies on economic liberalization, cultural adaptation, and technological change.
- Citations from academic journals, books, and reports add to the article's credibility.

✓ Incorporation of Psychological and Social Dimensions

- The discussion on bicultural identity, identity confusion, and mental health concerns due to globalization is insightful.
- The paper makes an interdisciplinary connection between sociology, economics, and psychology, which enriches the analysis.

Areas for Improvement

REVIEWER'S REPORT

✗ Language and Grammatical Errors

- The article contains numerous spelling, grammatical, and typographical errors that affect readability. For example:
 - "IMPECT" instead of "IMPACT" in the title.
 - "SOCIO AND CULTURAL IMPECT OF GLOBALIZATION WITH IN INDIAN CONCERN" is unclear and needs restructuring.
 - Awkward phrasing: *"In the end we can say that, every step of movement towards economic, political and culture , modernization..."* (should be revised for clarity).
- Recommendation: The paper should undergo thorough proofreading and editing to improve its academic tone and readability.

✗ Lack of Clear Thesis and Strong Conclusion

- While the article discusses various effects of globalization, it lacks a strong, focused argument or clear research question.
- The conclusion is vague and generalized, without summarizing key findings or providing a strong final statement.
- Recommendation: The introduction and conclusion should be revised to clearly state the main argument and key takeaways.

✗ Better Organization Needed

- Some sections appear disjointed and repetitive.
- The structure can be improved with clear headings and subheadings to guide the reader through different aspects of globalization.
- Recommendation: Improve section transitions and remove redundant explanations.

✗ Citations and References Need Formatting

- Some references are incomplete or incorrectly formatted (e.g., Wikipedia should be replaced with more scholarly sources).
- Many sources lack proper in-text citations to support specific claims.
- Recommendation: Follow a consistent citation style (APA, MLA, or Chicago) and ensure all references are properly cited within the text.

Final Recommendation: Accept

The article covers an important topic with relevant discussion.
